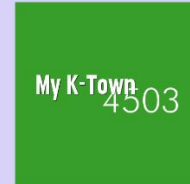

### Plastic bag ban in Queensland

From 1 July 2018, retailers are no longer allowed to supply shoppers with single-use lightweight plastic shopping bags under 35 microns, either free or for a charge.

This ban includes compostable, degradable and biodegradable plastic shopping bags.

### Compliance and reporting

The ban applies to all retail businesses for in-store and online sales. A fine of up to 50 penalty units per offence may apply for:

- not complying with the legislation
- or
- providing misleading information about plastic shopping bags.

The Queensland Government, with the National Retail Association (NRA), continues to work with retailers and bag suppliers to ensure they comply with the plastic bag ban.
